WHAT IS CONSIDERED AN EMERGENCY?

You should visit the Emergency Department at White Plains Hospital for any life-threatening emergency.

- Severe abdominal pain
- Eye injuries
- Falls with injury
- Broken bones
- Fevers above 101 degrees
- Intestinal bleeding
- Chest pain
- Repeated vomiting
- Severe burns
- Seizures
- Heart palpitations
- Severe head injury
- Suspected poisoning or drug overdose
- Paralysis (Inability to move arm or leg)
- Lacerations requiring stitches
- Severe headache
- Severe sudden shortness of breath
- Fainting spells
- Motor vehicle accidents
